Keynote presenter **Michael S. Greco** is a partner with the Boston office of K&L Gates and is past president (2005–2006) of the 415,000-member American Bar Association (ABA). A trial lawyer, arbitrator, and mediator, he has more than 35 years of experience in complex business and other disputes throughout the United States and internationally. Mr. Greco has also served as president of the Massachusetts Bar Association, the New England Bar Association, the New England Bar Foundation, and the Board of Trustees of Massachusetts Continuing Legal Education, Inc.



The overarching theme of Mr. Greco's ABA presidency was renaissance—a rebirth and reaffirmation of the legal profession's core value and America's constitutional principles. During his term of office, he created two ABA commissions, five ABA task forces, and several special committees to implement his presidential initiatives and address issues of concern to the public and the legal profession. As ABA president, Mr. Greco traveled to 47 states, the District of Columbia, Puerto Rico, and approximately 30 nations, representing the American Bar Association and its 415,000 members.

Mr. Greco has served as Special Counsel to the Justices of the Massachusetts Supreme Judicial Court and the Board of Bar Overseers in *United States v. Klubock*, and as a Special Assistant Attorney General of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts. As a lecturer and writer on legal subjects, he has addressed issues of trial practice, arbitration, employment law, environmental law, professional malpractice, and legal ethics.

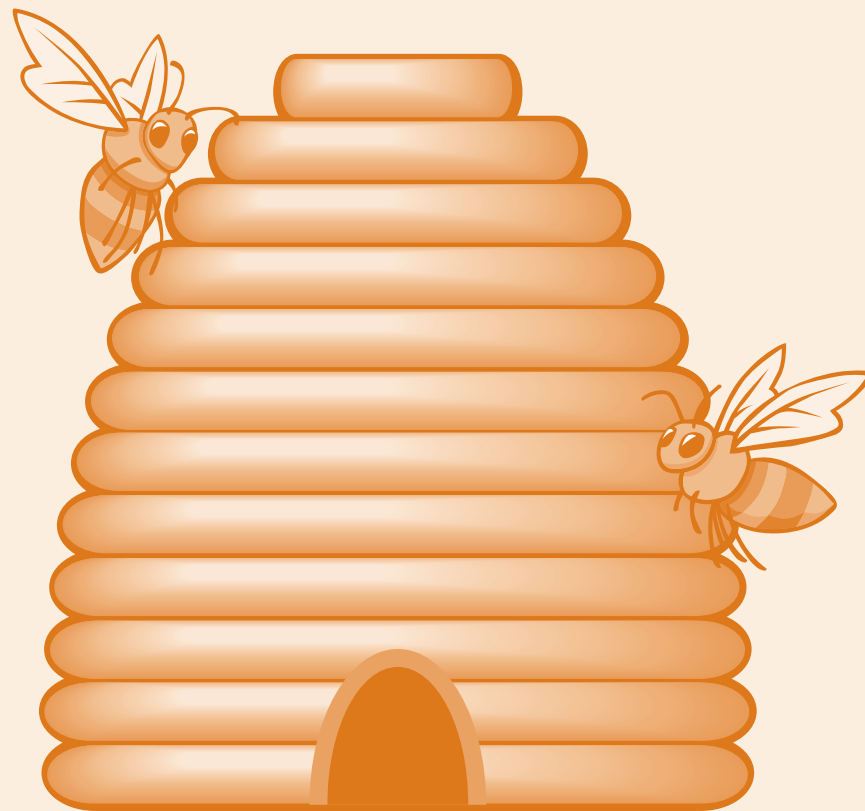
