Mr. Cohen is on the editorial board of the *Journal of Forensic Neuropsychology* and is a public member of the Board of Directors of the American Board of Professional Neuropsychology. Mr. Cohen speaks nationally to lawyers, insurance companies, governmental entities, risk managers, and other professional groups about litigation and trial practice matters, legal ethics, alternative dispute resolution, and issues in brain damage, law and medicine, and law and psychology. He has received awards from the Maricopa County Bar Association and the Arizona Bar Association for excellence in continuing legal education.
